A volunteer is needed to be a helper in Children's Church.

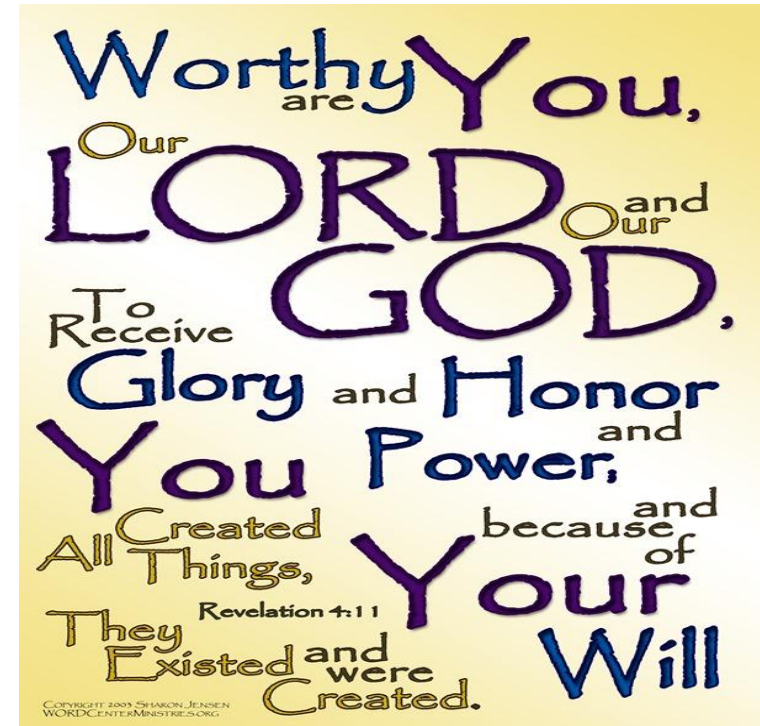
